Vote on ESSB5297, excludes all abstinence-only education
- 4. **Prohibit Abstinence-only Sex-Education**
Vote on ESB6305/HB2698, overturns Title V abstinence education funding
- 5. **Embryonic Stem Cell Research**
Vote on EHB1268, ends life of embryos
- 6. **Washington State Estate Tax**
Vote on ESB6096, re-imposing the estate tax
